At the end of July, Leslie and I were afforded the ability to go and visit one of our newest Missionaries. Brother Lucilo and Raquel Vasquez, with Iglesia Bautista Monte De Sion (Mount Zion Baptist Church), of Cabo San Lucas, Mexico. We began supporting Brother Vasquez this year at the request of Brother Roy Velez. We had asked him to share with us another ministry in Mexico that we could begin to work with in church planting. This seven year old church plant is already reaching out and supporting missionaries in other countries. But now their church is beginning an extension school of the church planting ministry working with Brother Velez. This is a new venture of this church and they presently have three students signed up to begin their studies. This area at the very southern tip of Baja California, Mexico they often just call Cabo. It is made up of many small villages, many of them having no church in their village. Brother Vasquez has a vision of planting many churches in these surrounding areas.

It was a great blessing for Leslie and I to be eye witness of this ministry, to see their zeal and to feel the heart beat of a people that long to see their city and country come to know the Lord that had saved them. There is just something about being there and walking in their steps and seeing these ministries that makes it real to a person. If you have never visited one of our missionaries, I would highly encourage you to do so, it is a life changing experience! This is a tourist area and I wasn't sure what to expect as we went. But if you have ever been to one of these areas, you'll know what I mean when I say it was like walking in two different worlds. The beaches are very nice and surrounded by huge well adorned hotels where no expense is spared at making it look like a paradise. But when you walk from the beach, past the hotel and then past the highway, everything changes. Baja California is a hot, dry desert and there are literally cactus everywhere. They pay a high price for usable water. There is very little to no industry to support the population. But there are tourists... at the hotels and beaches. So almost all of the income flows from that area. Although by United States standards, many of the people are poor monetarily, they are every bit as important to God as any other. Your heart rejoices with them as you see the joy of Christ welling up inside of them as they recognize the grace of their God. These folks are excited to see what God can do in their lives as they submit to His will and call. I think it's great that God has given us the ability to be a part of what He is doing in this area. I am sure we will be sharing more and more as the days go on about what we can do in the future to help this thriving ministry in Mexico.

We just need to remember that beginning part of calling unto Him. We shouldn't view talking to God as an obligation. Talking to God should be viewed as a privilege. The God of the universe WANTS to hear from you. He doesn't need to, your word doesn't do anything for Him, but He wants to commune with His—creation.

To finish I just want to say thank you again to everyone for their prayer and general support. Thank you to our teenagers for answering the call to ministry this summer. Thank you to our wonderful parents who faithfully serve their kids on a daily basis and give their kids opportunities to step out by faith and serve the Lord. Again, to our parents, thank you for giving Leah and I the privilege to serve your kids – it is an honor, and we love them! Lastly, thank you Lord for your greatness and might, and being so kind and good to us even when we fall so short of deserving it!

## **Big Christian Word**

**Relationship:** The State of being connected to someone. A mother, father, sister, brother, etc. Friendship, closeness to someone. God wants us to have a relationship with Him. (James 4:8) (Psalms 73:28) (James 2:23)

## My God Knows Me

"O Lord, thou hast searched me, and known me. . . For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O Lord, thou knowest it altogether." (Psalm 139:1, 4)

How many words do you speak in a day? Have you ever counted? Probably not! But did you know that God knows how many words you spoke today? Not only that, but He knows *what* words you spoke and exactly what you were thinking when you said them! He knows if your words were kind or unkind, loving or unloving, respectful or disrespectful. He knows if you just talked about yourself all day or if you thought to ask about someone else's life.

Psalm 139 says that God knows *everything* about you! It even says that He knows every time you sit down and every time you get back up. He knows everything you say, everything you do, and even everything you think (both good and bad.) No one else knows that much about you, not even your Mom or Dad or your best friend.

This psalm also says that God is always with you. You cannot run away or hide from God like you can from other people.

So, if God knows everything about you, and He is always with you, what does that mean? It means that you must remember to obey Him. Ask God to help you remember to speak only good and kind words, and ask Him to help you do and think right things.

If you are a Christian, it should comfort you to know that God is always with you and that He knows all about you. You should be glad when His voice talks to your heart when you do wrong. Always listen to His voice and obey right away. There is nothing that will make you ultimately happier than pleasing Him. God knows you better and loves you more than anyone else in the whole world.

# Medora's Munchies

## **Strawberry Yogurt Bark Recipe**

### Ingredients:

- 2 cups nonfat Greek yogurt, I like Fage, or Dairy Free Yogurt
- 1 cup fresh strawberries, divided, ½ cup sliced
- 1/4 cup honey
- 3/4 teaspoon vanilla extract
- pinch of salt
- ¼ cup whole raw pistachios or another nut. Chocolate chips. You can vary fruit.

#### **Instructions:**

Line a small 13 x 9-inch baking sheet with parchment paper.

In a food processor or blender pitcher, add yogurt, honey, 1/2 cup of the strawberries, vanilla and pinch of salt. Blend on high until smooth throughout, roughly 10-15 seconds.

Pour mixture onto baking sheet, and use an offset spatula to spread out evenly.

Top off with the remaining strawberries and nuts.

Set in the freezer for roughly 2 hours to set. Cut into 12 pieces and eat frozen.

For more servings: you may double or triple it.
